

Discover and Live Your Future Invitation: Question Guide

These questions are for reflection, sharing and discussion after watching the [Discover and Live Your Future](#) video.

The following scriptures and practices are mentioned in the video. Please feel free to share them as your community begins to engage with the questions that support the video.

Doctrine and Covenants 163:1

“Community of Christ,” your name, given as a divine blessing, is your identity and calling. If you will discern and embrace its full meaning, you will not only discover your future, you will become a blessing to the whole creation. Do not be afraid to go where it beckons you to go.

Mission Prayer:

God, where will your Spirit lead today?
Help me be fully awake and ready to respond.
Grant me courage to risk something new
And become a blessing of your love and peace. Amen.

Matthew 11:28-30 The Message (MSG)

²⁸⁻³⁰ “Are you tired? Worn out? Burned out on religion? Come to me. Get away with me and you’ll recover your life. I’ll show you how to take a real rest. Walk with me and work with me—watch how I do it. Learn the unforced rhythms of grace. I won’t lay anything heavy or ill-fitting on you. Keep company with me and you’ll learn to live freely and lightly.”

The questions below are group together in themes. Feel free to use the theme / questions that are appropriate in your context. These questions can be used for silent reflection, journaling, sharing in pairs and small group sharing, or sharing in a large group.

Doctrine and Covenants 163:1

1. What does the name “Community of Christ” mean to you?
2. For you, what is the essence of loving and inviting Christian community? When or where have you experienced this type of community?

Mission Prayer:

1. How does the Mission Prayer point to the essence of who we are as Community of Christ?
2. How can you create space to be open and aware of God's presence in your life? In the life of your community?
3. How has the mission prayer disrupted your life? What has been your response?
4. How do we live the mission prayer as communities that gather?

Authentic, Loving, Christian Community:

1. How can the power of loving community and our role in that community change the world?

Awaken:

1. How are you aware of what God is doing in you, among you and ahead of you?
2. What are the ways our community can grow in discipleship and relationship?

Risk:

1. How can you risk new conversations? New relationships? New forms of community?
2. What questions are you asking around faith and response?
3. What steps are you taking to risk something new in your life and the life of your community?

Bless:

1. How do we embody Christ's love and peace in the world?
2. What does it mean to say that God is constantly on the move?
3. What kind of blessing are you needing in your life?
4. What type of blessing do you have to offer the world?

Spiritual Practices:

1. What spiritual practices ground you in God and give you life?
2. How is the Spirit calling you to slow down, be more present and aware?
3. When have spiritual practices felt like a "check list" to you? How have you responded to those feelings?
4. What spiritual practices do you do alone (in relationship with God)? What practices do you experience in community (in relationship with others)?

Let's rediscover the power of loving community together as people called and sent -in the name of Christ -to the world.
